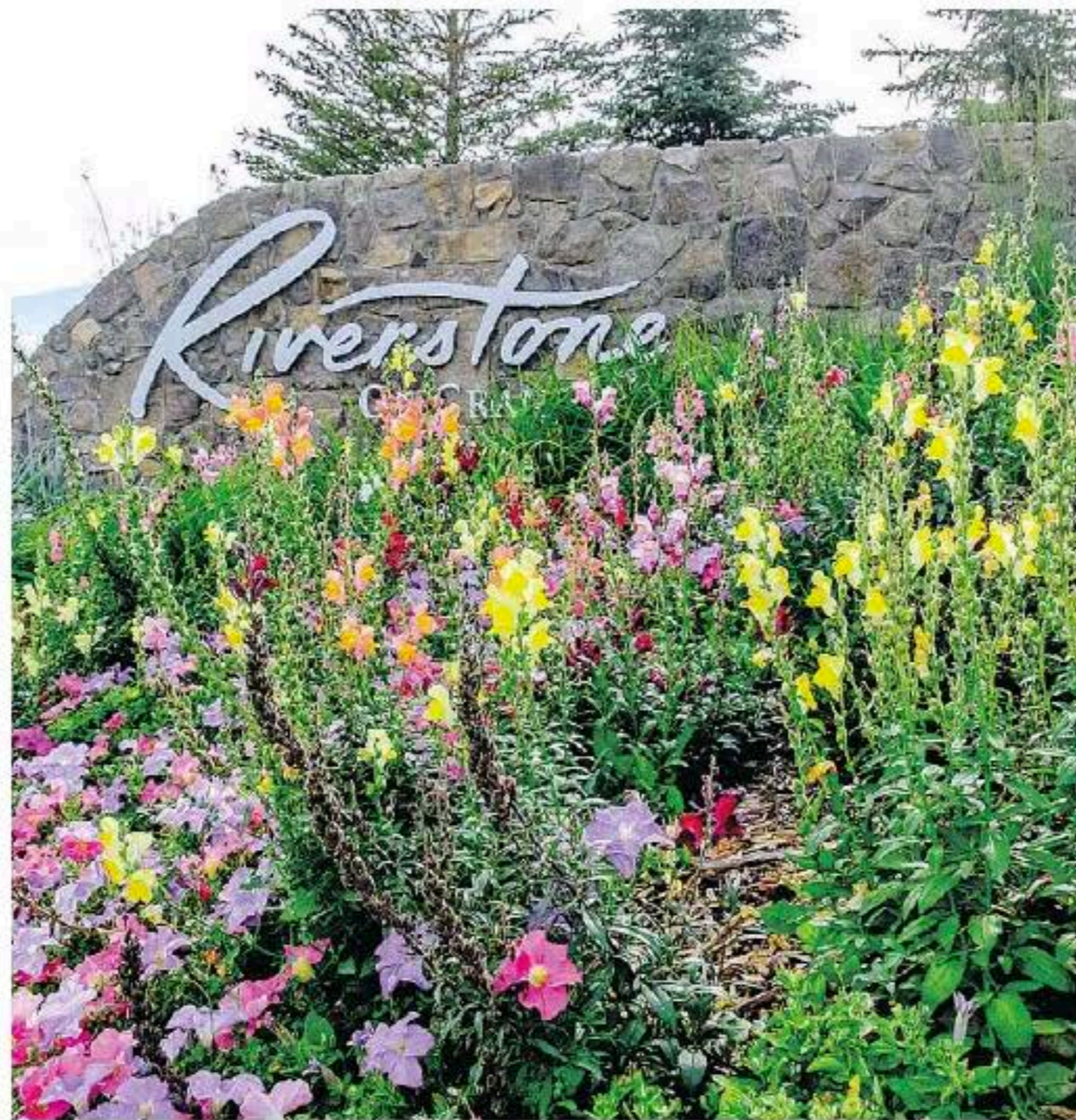

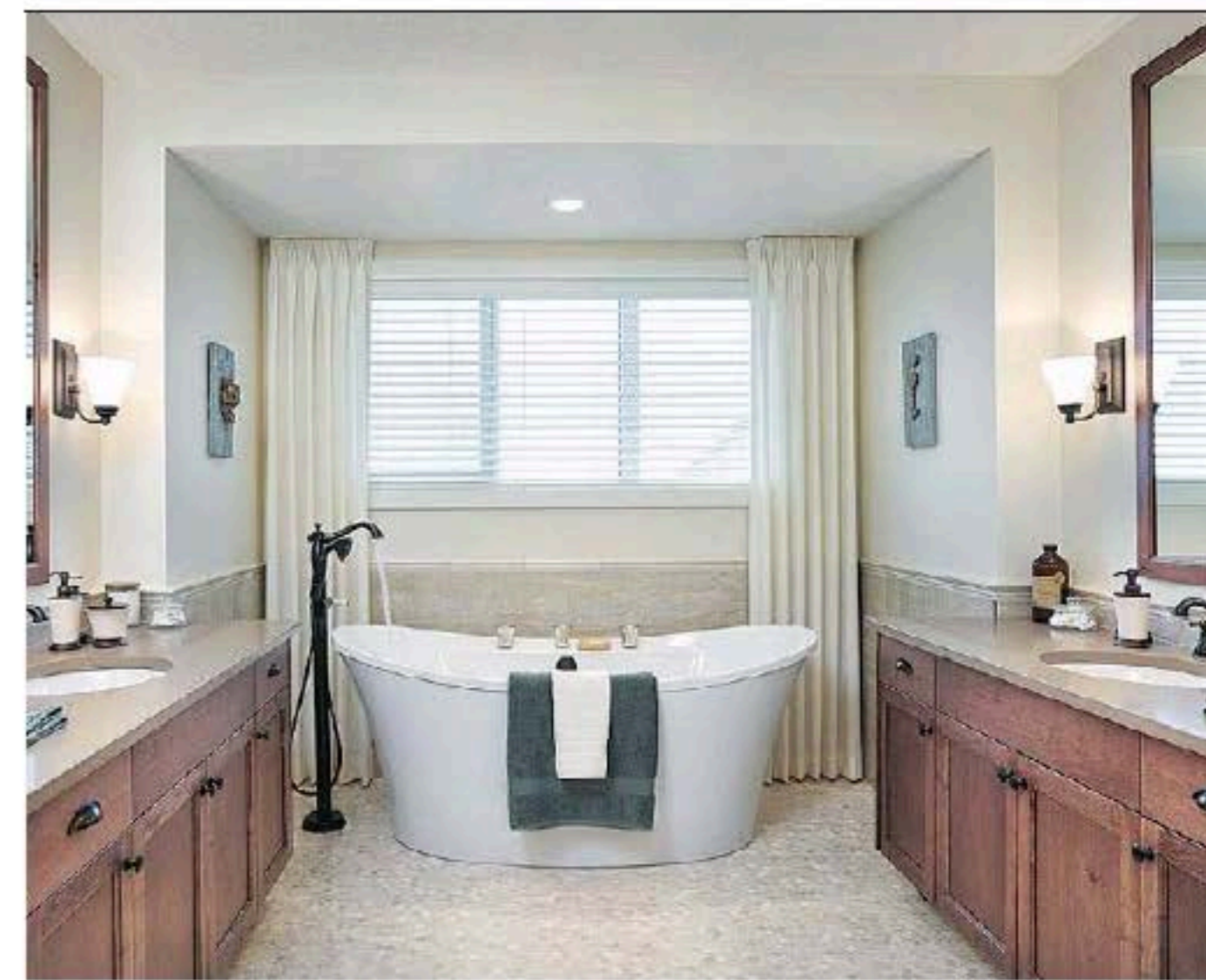
Champagne, by Remington Development Corp., won the Multi-Family Project category.

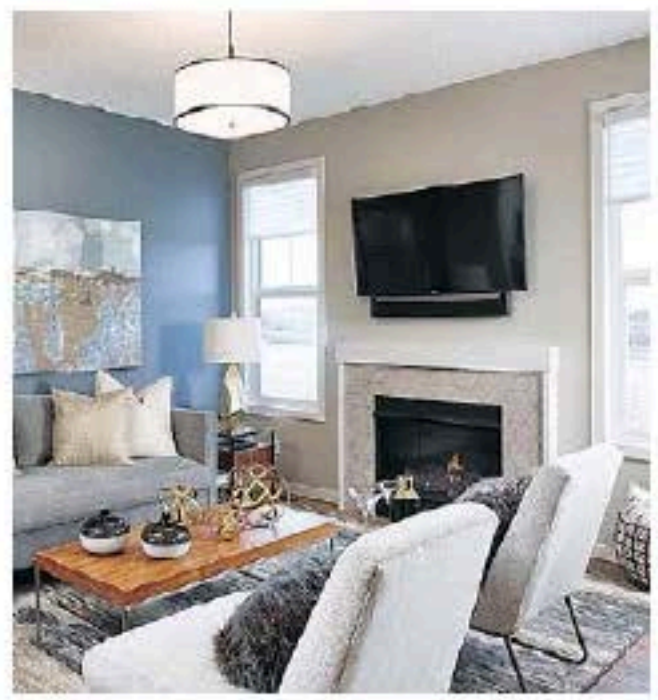
